There will be NO REFUNDS allowed if you are asked to leave for breaking this rule.

TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The Vermont State Senior Open and Women's Championships will be held on December 7, 8, 14, & 15, 2024, at Valley Bowl, Randolph Vermont. These are two separate championship tournaments.
2. **Tournament Eligibility**
 - A. **Each bowler must be at least 50 years of age as of July 1, 2025.**
 - B. Each bowler must be a member in good standing of a Vermont Bowling Association chartered through the USBC; and *must have a certified average in a Vermont association from the 2023-2024 season (minimum 21 games) or the 2024-2025 season (minimum nine games) by November 17, 2024.*
3. USBC rules will prevail as appropriate.
4. Competition will consist of a total of six games bowled in two blocks of three games each. This is a classified handicap singles event, with separate divisions determined by the age of the bowler as shown on the front of the entry form.
5. Each bowler may participate in a tournament only once. Bowlers shall select their two squad times from among those listed on the front of the entry form. Women shall specify whether they wish to participate in the Open Division, Women's Division, or both. If they choose to enter both tournaments, separate entry forms must be submitted for each tournament and squad times selected for each. Games bowled for one tournament will not count for both tournaments.
6. The handicap will be 90% of 220 determined on a per game basis without limit.
7. Entries must be postmarked on or before midnight Friday, November 22, 2024.
8. Prize fees will be returned 100%. The prize ratio, based upon divisional entries, will be one in four.
9. Entries will not be accepted without full payment of the tournament fees. Incomplete entry forms may be returned at the discretion of the tournament directors.
10. Lanes will be assigned or drawn by the tournament directors.
11. Selected squad time will be honored unless the bowler is notified to the contrary by a tournament director.
12. If a tie exists for first place within an age classification, co-champions will be declared. For purposes of determining who will be eligible for the USBC Senior Championships (National Finals), the bowler with the highest game with handicap will advance. If a tie still exists, the second-highest game with handicap will be used, etc.
13. The winner of each of the six major divisions (Super Senior, A, B, C, D, E) is eligible to enter the National Finals. If the winner chooses not to attend the National Finals, the opportunity passes to the second-place finisher and this process follows down the standings list until a finisher accepts. The entry fee to the National Finals must be paid by the VT State USBC. ***** National Finals attendees will be required to pay the event's entry fee to VT State USBC to reserve their spots in the event. Upon completion of the qualifying rounds at the National Finals, VT State USBC will reimburse participants the entry fees. *****
14. **Entering Average**
 - A. Use the highest certified average from the 2022-23 or 2023-24 winter, summer or composite based on 21 or more games
 - B. If the bowler has no certified average (minimum 21 games) from these preceding seasons, use the bowler's highest composite average (minimum 21 games) of each season.
 - C. If A and B above do not apply, the current season average for 21 or more games as of November 17, 2024, is acceptable.
 - D. If the bowler does not have an acceptable average determined under A, B or C above, the bowler may bowl scratch provided he/she meets the eligibility requirements of Rule #2.
15. USBC Rule 319a3: Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages, whether submitted by the bowlers or others. If a submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
16. USBC Rule 319a4: Average corrections can be made up to the end of the bowler's first game of the first series.
17. Bowlers who qualify for an award can expect to have their average verified by their local association secretary or representative.
18. USBC Rules 319a2, 319d, and 319e do not apply to bowlers in this tournament.
19. Interpretation of these rules and other matters surrounding the State Senior Championships are the responsibility of the tournament directors. Their decisions are final. The bowlers have the right to appeal decisions provided such appeal is in writing and in accord with USBC Rule 329.
